## **TASTING NOTES**

Light purple in colour with a lustrous hue. Ripe strawberry, cherry and raspberry aromas are joined by a cream and vanilla bouquet. The same flavours mimic the berry aromas. Vanilla undertones, lent to the wine from oak aging, are perceptible in the clean, but supple finish.

## **PRODUCTION NOTES**

Pinot Noir grapes were harvested between August 17th and September 1st, 2016, with an average Brix of 25.1.
