“ The 2015 Chianti Classico Gran Selezione is a tight and streamlined wine with wild berry aromas, cassis, licorice and mild spice. I can't say that there is huge intensity here—the wine has more of a measured and mild nature, but it is pleasantly streamlined and elegant from start to finish. It's a great match for a Tuscan bean soup and freshly baked bread. Some 20,000 bottles were made.
