


## DOMAINE JEAN GRIVOT Vosne-Romanée 1er cru Les Beaux Monts 2019



Very dark with a purple rim. Ripe, intense black fruits. That nutty aroma again with the merest hint of curry leaf, peppery and spiced. On the palate, firm, chewy, more savoury but with the richness of black fruit and a hint of violets. Dark and savoury on the finish. Compact and seems to be an odd contradiction: firm tannins need time but the fruit is so ripe. Complex and hard to gauge its ageability.
